Philosophy ~ We believe in open communication between our staff and you as parents working together to ensure the greatest amount of concern, safety, and happiness for your child.

Discipline ~ Our disciplinary techniques include giving choices, problem-solving, natural and logical consequences and re-directing. Parents will be kept informed of any problems or incidents.

Inappropriate behavior includes:

- ✓ Aggressive or harmful behavior
- ✓ Inappropriate language
- ✓ Disregard of rules
- ✓ Consistent disruption of the program
- ✓ Extreme disrespect shown to others

In the event that a child's behavior is a continued disruption of our routine and program the following procedure will be adhered to:

- ✓ The parent will be made aware of the problem. Staff and parent(s) will attempt to come to a solution and a warning will be given.
- ✓ A second warning is given in a written letter to the child's parent(s). And a parent - teacher conference will take place.
- ✓ If there is a 3rd warning, they will have to repeat that grade level.
