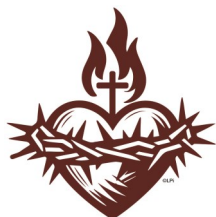




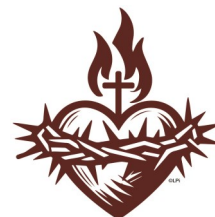

St. Paul's Memorial Society

Would you like to enroll a deceased loved one in St. Paul's Memorial Society? Your loved one's name will be inscribed in our Book of Remembrance which rests in an oak case beneath the 14th Station of the Cross in church (our Shrine of Remembrance.) The 14th Station of the Cross reminds us of Jesus's disciples placing His body in the tomb on the first Good Friday afternoon.

The window next to our Shrine of Remembrance depicts the Pieta (our Blessed Mother holding the lifeless body of Jesus in her lap). The Book of Remembrance contains all the days of the calendar year. Names of those enrolled in the Memorial Society appear according to the date they died. Above our Shrine of Remembrance, a brief message

Let Us Pray for Those Who Have Died This Day.

Every day as worshippers pass the Shrine, they see the names of those who left this world on that particular day. Additionally, all of the members of the Memorial Society are remembered in a special Liturgy on the First Friday of every month.

Enrollment donation for membership in the Memorial Society is \$100. Please stop in the Office if you wish to enroll your deceased loved ones.
