Terms of Service

Effective date: September 14, 2026

1. Acceptance of These Terms

By inviting, accessing, or using Sticker Scout (the "Bot" or "Service"), you agree to these Terms of Service. If you do not agree, do not use the Service. If you use Sticker Scout on behalf of a Discord server or organization, you represent that you have authority to do so.

2. About Sticker Scout

Sticker Scout is an unofficial Discord utility designed to help users organize Monopoly GO! sticker information, maintain player profiles, identify needed and duplicate stickers, and locate potential trade matches within participating Discord communities. Sticker Scout is not affiliated with, endorsed by, sponsored by, or operated by Scopely, Hasbro, Monopoly, Discord, or their affiliates.

The Service does not guarantee the availability, authenticity, ownership, tradability, rarity, value, or successful transfer of any sticker or in-game item.

3. Eligibility and Discord Requirements

You must be permitted to use Discord and the relevant Discord server under Discord's applicable terms and age requirements. Server owners and administrators are responsible for deciding whether Sticker Scout may be installed or used in their communities.

4. User Profiles and Submitted Information

Sticker Scout may allow you to provide an in-game name (IGN), Monopoly GO! friend code, friend link, sticker inventory, screenshots, and related information. You are responsible for the accuracy of information you submit and for ensuring you have the right to submit it.

Do not submit passwords, authentication tokens, payment-card information, government identification numbers, private messages, or other unnecessary sensitive information.

5. Screenshot and Inventory Processing

Sticker Scout may provide screenshot-assisted album or sticker recognition. Automated image recognition can be inaccurate. Users are responsible for reviewing and confirming detected sticker information before relying on it. The Service may require manual correction or manual inventory entry when confidence is insufficient.

Sticker Scout may change, remove, or limit screenshot-processing functionality as Monopoly GO! interfaces, album layouts, or technical requirements change.

6. Trading and User-to-User Interactions

Sticker Scout may identify users who appear to have complementary sticker inventories or facilitate trade proposals. Sticker Scout is not a party to trades between users and does not take custody of stickers, accounts, money, or other property.

You are solely responsible for evaluating another user, confirming trade terms, verifying in-game information, and deciding whether to complete a trade. Do not send money, account credentials, verification codes, or other sensitive information through Sticker Scout. Any disputes, failed trades, scams, mistaken sends, or account consequences are between the participating users.

7. Prohibited Conduct

You may not use Sticker Scout to scam, defraud, harass, impersonate, spam, manipulate trade records, distribute malware, evade platform enforcement, obtain unauthorized access, scrape or abuse the Service, interfere with operation of the Bot, or violate applicable law, Discord rules, Monopoly GO! rules, or third-party rights.

Automated abuse, excessive requests, attempts to bypass rate limits, or use intended to degrade availability may result in restrictions or termination.

8. Intellectual Property and Third-Party Rights

Sticker Scout's original software, branding, documentation, and original creative materials are protected by applicable intellectual-property laws. Monopoly, Monopoly GO!, Scopely, Hasbro, Discord, and other third-party names, marks, artwork, game assets, and content remain the property of their respective owners.

Nothing in these Terms grants you ownership of third-party intellectual property. Sticker Scout should not be represented as an official Monopoly GO! product.

9. Availability, Changes, and Termination

The Service is provided on an as-available basis. Features may be changed, suspended, rate-limited, reset, or discontinued without guarantee of advance notice. Album catalogs and inventory data may require updates when game seasons change.

Access may be suspended or terminated for abuse, security concerns, legal requirements, platform requirements, or violation of these Terms.

10. Disclaimer of Warranties
