

Poppy Bot — Privacy Policy

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy explains how Poppy (“the Bot”) collects, uses, and protects information when used within Discord servers.

2. Information Collected

Poppy may collect and store:

- User IDs
- Server IDs
- Channel IDs
- User preferences (such as tracked Kirby numbers)
- Configuration settings set by server administrators

3. How Information is Used

Collected data is used solely to:

- Provide alerts and notifications
- Maintain user preferences and lists
- Operate bot features such as forwarding, summaries, and directories
- Improve functionality and performance

4. Data Storage

Data is stored securely and only retained as long as necessary to operate the Bot’s features.

5. What We Do NOT Collect

Poppy does not:

- Access or store private (direct) message content
- Store message content beyond what is required for functionality
- Collect personal identifying information beyond Discord IDs
- Sell, rent, or share data with third parties

6. Data Sharing

No user data is sold or shared. Data is only processed internally for bot functionality.

7. User Control

Users can:

- Remove their tracked numbers
- Disable direct messages at any time
- Stop using the Bot to cease data collection

Server administrators can:

- Remove the Bot from their server at any time

8. Security

Reasonable measures are taken to protect stored data, but no system is completely secure.

9. Children's Privacy

Poppy does not knowingly collect personal data from children outside of standard Discord usage.

10. Changes to This Policy

This Privacy Policy may be updated at any time. Continued use of the Bot constitutes acceptance of any changes.
