

STICKER SCOUT

Privacy Policy

Effective date: September 14, 2026

1. Scope

This Privacy Policy describes how Sticker Scout (the "Bot" or "Service") may collect, use, store, and disclose information when users interact with Sticker Scout through Discord. Sticker Scout is an unofficial community utility and is not affiliated with Scopely, Hasbro, Monopoly, Monopoly GO!, or Discord.

2. Information You Provide

Depending on the features you use, Sticker Scout may process information you intentionally submit, including your Monopoly GO! in-game name (IGN), friend code, friend link, sticker inventory quantities, needed stickers, duplicate stickers, trade selections, album screenshots, and information submitted through Bot commands or interactive components.

You should not submit passwords, Discord tokens, Monopoly GO! account credentials, payment-card information, government identifiers, medical information, or other unnecessary sensitive personal information.

3. Discord Information

When you use Sticker Scout, the Service may process Discord-provided identifiers and context needed to operate commands, such as your Discord user ID, server/guild ID, channel or interaction context, display information made available through Discord, and command interaction metadata.

The Bot does not need your Discord password. Discord authentication and platform account security are handled by Discord.

4. Screenshots and Image Processing

If you submit an album screenshot, Sticker Scout may process the image to identify sticker-set information, collected stickers, missing stickers, or duplicate quantities. Automated recognition may be imperfect and may require user confirmation.

Operational deployments should retain screenshots only for as long as necessary to process the requested import unless a separate feature clearly tells users that an image will be stored. Temporary copies, caches, hosting logs, or backups may persist for limited periods depending on the hosting environment.

5. How Information Is Used

Information may be used to create and display player profiles; maintain sticker inventories; calculate album progress; identify needed and duplicate stickers; find potential trade matches; display friend information when requested; process screenshot-assisted imports; prevent abuse; troubleshoot errors; maintain security; and operate, improve, or support the Service.

6. Visibility to Other Users

Sticker Scout is designed around community sticker matching. Information you choose to place in your Sticker Scout profile - such as IGN, friend code, friend link, inventory status, needed stickers, duplicates, and trade-match information - may be displayed to other users in the same Discord server when they use relevant Bot commands.

Do not add information to your Sticker Scout profile that you do not want exposed through these community features.

7. Data Storage

Sticker Scout may store structured profile and inventory information in its application database. The initial deployment uses SQLite unless the operator changes the storage architecture. Hosting providers may also process technical logs, backups, network information, or infrastructure metadata as part of providing hosting services.

Reasonable safeguards should be used to protect stored information, but no online service or storage system can guarantee absolute security.

8. Data Sharing

Sticker Scout does not need to sell personal information to provide its core functionality. Information may be disclosed to other Discord users as described above; to hosting, infrastructure, or service providers as necessary to operate the Service; when required by law or valid legal process; to investigate abuse or security incidents; or as necessary to protect users, the Service, or third-party rights.

Information may also be processed by Discord when you interact with the Bot, subject to Discord's own policies and practices.

9. Data Retention

Profile and sticker-inventory data may be retained while a user or server continues to use Sticker Scout or while the information is reasonably necessary to provide the Service. Data may also remain temporarily in backups or logs after deletion from the active database.

Album-season changes may cause old inventory information to be archived, reset, or removed as part of normal Bot operation.

10. User Choices and Deletion Requests

Users should be provided a reasonable method to update inaccurate profile or inventory information. Where supported, users may remove or reset their own stored Sticker Scout profile and inventory. If self-service deletion is not available, users may contact Sticker Scout/Britt's Bots support to request deletion of stored Bot profile data associated with their Discord user ID.

Certain minimal records may be retained when reasonably necessary for security, abuse prevention, legal compliance, dispute resolution, or backup integrity.

11. Children

Sticker Scout is not designed to independently collect information from children outside the context of Discord use. Users must satisfy Discord's applicable eligibility and age requirements. Do not use Sticker Scout to solicit unnecessary personal information from minors.

12. Security

Reasonable technical and organizational measures may include limiting database access, protecting bot credentials and environment variables, applying software updates, restricting unnecessary Discord permissions, and monitoring

operational errors. Users are responsible for protecting their own Discord and Monopoly GO! accounts and should never share passwords or authentication codes through the Bot.

13. International Processing

Depending on where the Bot, Discord, hosting provider, or infrastructure services operate, information may be processed in locations different from your own. Applicable privacy rights may vary by jurisdiction.

14. Changes to This Policy

This Privacy Policy may be updated when Sticker Scout features, hosting, data practices, or legal requirements change. The effective date at the top identifies the current version.

15. Contact

Privacy questions and requests should be directed through the official Sticker Scout/Britt's Bots support channel or other contact method designated by the Bot operator. For a deletion request, users should provide their Discord user ID and enough information to identify the Sticker Scout profile involved, but should not provide passwords or authentication credentials.
