

### **Your Story Matters**

Use these **five key prompts** to structure your story. You don't have to answer everything—just focus on what resonates with you.

#### 1. Set the Scene: How It All Started

- What first brought you into the service industry? Was it intentional, or did you fall into it unexpectedly?
- Did you have a moment when you realized, "This is where I belong"?
- What was your first job, and how did it shape your journey?

**Example Answer:** "I never planned to work in a kitchen. I was struggling to find direction, and a friend got me a dishwashing job at a small diner. It wasn't glamorous, but something about the energy of the kitchen pulled me in. I worked my way up, and before I knew it, I was hooked."

### 2. The Grind & The Struggle

- What's been the hardest challenge you've faced in the industry?

### 3. A Defining Moment

- Was there a moment when you realized your hard work was paying off?
- Did a mentor, coworker, or experience change the way you saw this industry?
- What's a memory that sticks with you—good or bad—that defines your journey?

**Example Answer:** "One night, our line got slammed. Tickets flying in, the heat unbearable. I thought I was drowning. But I found my rhythm, kept my head down, and executed perfectly. The chef pulled me aside after service and said, 'That's how it's done.' That moment made me realize—I'm built for this."

## 4. What Keeps You Going?

- Why do you stay in this industry despite the challenges?
- What do you love most about what you do?
- If you had to describe the feeling of a perfect service, what would it be?

**Example Answer:** "There's nothing like that rush when service is in full swing—when you and your team move like a machine, every plate is perfect, and you feel unstoppable. That's what keeps me coming back."

# 5. Words for Others

- What advice would you give to someone just starting out in this industry?
- If you could go back and tell your younger self something, what would it be?
- What do you want people outside of the industry to understand about this work?

**Example Answer:** "You're going to want to quit a hundred times, but don't. Every rough shift, every mistake—it's all part of the process. Keep your head down, listen, and never stop learning."
