STATUS OF 2022 GOALS:

2022 Goal 1: Build & Grow Each Annual Event

PROGRESS: In 2022, The Outcome hosted a "2nd Annual" of each event established in 2021. Additionally, the "Shark in the Park Fun Run" was offered on two dates in order to bring this event directly to Tulia and Lockney. The Outcome hoped this would increase participation and alleviate some of the barriers to attendance (gas, travel) among lower income families. This was a huge success, particularly in the Lockney community!

2022 Goal 2: Gain Non Profit Status

PROGRESS: With the help of local funding sources and donations The Outcome completed the application process for 501c(3) status in 2022 and was approved as a Non-Profit Incorporation in June 2022. This was an exciting step for The Outcome, as it will allow us to apply for state and federal grant funding. Our goal is to obtain funding to support our current and future initiatives without the need for local sponsorships and donations.

2022 Goal 3: Begin Initiatives in Tulia

PROGRESS: The Green Pearl Greenhouse located in Tulia and owned/operated by The Outcome Founder, Nichole Schmalzried opened in April 2022. Throughout the summer one community story time was completed with local youth and included a craft/gardening project. Space has also been acquired to begin a "Outcome Closet" on site for the Tulia community. These initiatives will continue to be developed and expanded in 2023.

2022 Goal 4: Increase Social Media Outreach

PROGRESS: This goal is an ongoing focus for The Outcome team. While not accomplished to the degree we had hoped in 2022, we did add to the collection of blogs and connected with past and new supporters through social media platforms. Our team has set a goal to increase our social media presence and connection on a more consistent basis, rather than primarily during peak event seasons/events.

While we love each special event, the continuous progress, relationships and one-on-one connection we have with children and families at The Outcome Closet (Lockney) and The Green Pearl Greenhouse (Tulia) are incredibly meaningful and bring to light the true purpose of this mission. While God placed this mission on our hearts to promote positive impact where we live, He didn't place a number in our minds to gauge success. We are continually reminded of this through these small, intimate spaces and projects. We believe that this 10' X 12' building and 15 square feet of garden space are where true impact is being made, and it is pretty incredible to experience!







The Outcome Closet

The Outcome Closet provides ALL families in Lockney with access to gently used clothing, shoes, toys and essential items completely FREE OF CHARGE. We are in our second year of operations and have included many volunteers in the daily washing, organizing, and restocking of donations. The community has shown up in stride with a wealth of donations and we are growing awareness within the community. With approximately 5-10 families visiting a month (more during season changes) we are breaking down barriers and opening minds to the fact that gently used clothing is a way we can help our neighbors and spend hard earned money elsewhere!

In addition to seasonal business operations, The Green Greenhouse Pearl also provides vouth opportunities enrichment empowerment with their craft and story time throughout the summer. Story time will continue in 2023, as well as the opening of The Outcome Closet - Tulia soon. We are so excited to be expanding these initiatives and look forward to how they will continue to grow. We hope to include more story times with increased promotion and awareness.
