## What happens next?

When we receive a report that is about a child we have the following options. The route we take depends on the information we receive but will always be with the aim of keeping a child safe.

- 1. Support in School
- 2. Early help out of school
- 3. Referral to Local Authority Children's Services
- 4. Reporting to the Police
