



One week ago, at a political debate in Van Zandt County, District Attorney Tonda Curry lost her composure and confronted a local resident—who is legally disabled and one of her most vocal critics—on camera.

In the recorded exchange, she threatened to prosecute him for "lying on a form" related to his disability status while cooking barbecue .

The video, posted on Facebook, TikTok, and Instagram, has amassed nearly two million views nationwide.

Thousands of comments from viewers across the United States have condemned her actions as unethical, unprofessional, and unfit for an elected prosecutor. This incident reveals the true character that critics, including myself, have highlighted for years.

District Attorney Curry has embarrassed herself, the Van Zandt County District Attorney's Office, the county, and the state of Texas.

Her conduct demonstrates a clear abuse of prosecutorial authority—using the threat of criminal charges to silence dissent. Such lawfare by elected officials has no place in our nation or our county.

This is not an isolated lapse; it is the first time her aggressive response to disagreement has been captured on video.

If Tonda Curry possessed genuine professionalism or moral integrity, she would resign immediately and return to private practice to restore public trust in the office.

It is time Tonda Curry packs her bag and leaves, taking the dark clouds with her that she has placed over Van Zandt County.
