## **Cowboy State Stock Horse Schedule**

March 28/29, 2020 CSSHA Ranch Versatility Thermopolis Indoor Arena

Saturday – Herd work Show #4 starts at 10 A.M., there will be no Wyoming High School Rodeo classes on Saturday.

Sunday – Reining/Fence/Box Show #5 & #6 starts at 10 A.M., Sunday will include High School Rodeo classes. High School rodeo contestants will make two runs on Sunday. The first run will be after the open class, the second High School run will be immediately after the CSSHA Youth Classes. After a contestant has completed their reining pattern, they may call for their cow to complete the fence run or boxing, if they did not enter the cow work, they will exit the arena at that point. If a contestant just entered the cow work, they will call for the cow as soon as they enter the arena. Reining and cattle are separate events. Classes will run concurrently regardless of entering both classes. Secretary will post on the draw if it is Rein only or Cow only.

Reining pattern will be Pattern 8 (found on page 50 of the CSSHA Winter Series Rulebook & Patterns 2019-2020) for all CSSHA Classes, Pattern 7 (page 49 of rulebook) for youth CSSHA classes, and the High School Rodeo pattern is 11/12 NRCHA pattern. Rulebook may be downloaded from the CSSHA website.

Entries are due by Tues. Mar. 24th and can be text or called into Leane Linnell, (307) 850-5122. Judge – Bruce Keller.

Order of classes is as follows: Open, High School Rodeo #1, Step Up Boxing, Non-Pro Fence, Non-Pro Boxing, Novice, Youth, High School Rodeo #2, and the Ferrari Class.

Added money classes pay back 70% of entry fee for all classes except the Novice, Youth. High School Rodeo will pay back 100‰ of the entry fees

We will present the awards at the arena in Thermopolis following the March 29th show. Winter Series Awards: First place, in each class, prizes are Gist Buckles with the CSSHA logo, second place will receive coolers, and third place will receive hay bags.
