Changes in Chester grocery business

CONTINUING their policy of moving with the times and of foreseeing trends in the grocery trade, the directors of George Dutton and Son Ltd. this week announce their forthcoming establishment of a mini-precinct in Godstall Lane, Chester, to accommodate three distinct shop units.

The directors, Mr. Neale Dutton, Mr. Piers Dutton and Mr. Donald Dutton, are all great grandsons of Mr. George Dutton who founded the business in 1854, in Bridge Street.

Later the business moved to Eastgate Street and the founder was succeeded by his son who was Mayor of Chester during the Great War.

The principal shop at 25, Eastgate Street is known as the Sgarro Stores. A Roman altar

'Sgarro' is a contraction of 'At the sign of the Roman Altar' in Latin.

HEALTH FOOD

Godstall Lane, with Dutton's health food shop, is behind the Eastgate Street shop and has vehicular access from St. Werburgh Street and pedestrian access from Eastgate Street Row.

The company has branches at Wrexham Oswestry and Saltney.

The directors announced this week "Now we have reached another milestone, because we feel that the bulky side of the grocery business is adequately catered for by completely impersonal methods of retailing, and the family business is better employed in selling high quality specialist foods and wines in small shops where contact between customers and staff can easily be maintained."

Brewers win cafe bar appeal

PLANS refused by licensing magistrates for a new cafe-bar have been granted on appeal.

Brewers JW Lees had applied to convert premises in Godstall Lane, off St Werburgh Street, Chester, into a new food and drink facility called Duttons.

After the application was turned by Chester Licensing Panel, the brewery appealed at Chester Crown Court on Friday, and won the case.

Speaking after the hearing, brewery estate manager Simon Lees-Jones said no firm date could be given for the opening.

The court heard the original objection had been based on the concerns of the police. Senior officers said they believed the pub could be used as a 'feeder' for nearby nightclubs like Rosies.

In upholding the appeal, Mr Justice Thomas, sitting with Chester magistrates, said they had taken police concerns into account but were impressed with the development.

The court heard a tenant acting in conjunction with JW Lees already held a full licence for the premises, granted by magistrates in 1993, which

But the brewery decided to re-apply for a new licence to create a cafe-bar that would hold fewer people and would serve food throughout opening times.

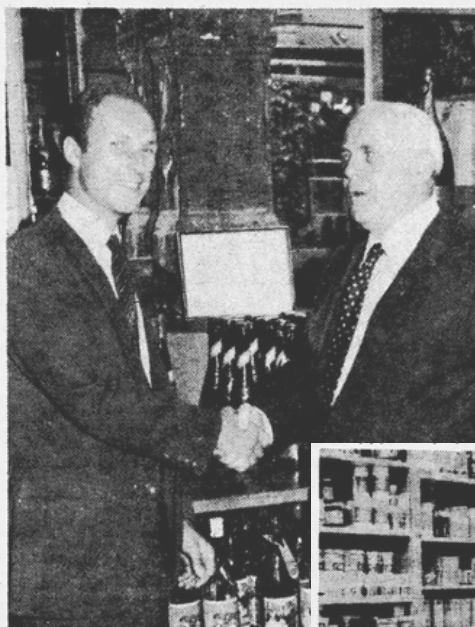
Chester Licensing Magistrates witnessed the end of an era this week when one of the oldest off-licences in their division changed hands.
