OUR PROGRAMS

Hubbard's Haven Daily Soup Kitchen

Hubbard's Haven Soup Kitchen was established more than 40 years ago and has been an important ministry serving those suffering from the effects of poverty: children, the elderly, the homeless, the mentally and physically disabled, and the working poor. It is the only facility in the Metro East area that offers free meals 7 days a week, 52 weeks a year!

Outreach Ministry Center

A multi-use space for many programs and services such as: Personal Identification Program assisting with I.D.'s and birth certificates; transportation, services for those experiencing homelessness, utility & rental assistance; budgeting, resume writing, job skills/search classes; housing assistance, social security assistance, computer center, clothing assistance, prison re-entry services and more.

Crisis Nite Center

Open from 7:00 pm – 7:00 am daily as a "safe haven" for all who come to spend the night. It is a "bridge" to existing services already provided by the Outreach Ministry where people access resources to assist in moving out of homelessness to housing.

OTHER SERVICES

THRIFT STORE

For over 50 years, our Thrift Store has furnished low cost clothing, household goods, and other merchandise to the poor.

Annually, more than 3,000 low-income people purchase goods at very minimal cost.

MOBILE KITCHEN MINISTRY

This ministry feeds an average of 80 people per night and serves more than 17,000 hot meals each year. The bus is staffed with crews made up of volunteers who prepare and bring the meals on the Bus four nights a week!
