FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



Dear Friends,

Since March 22^{nd,} our routine has changed drastically at St. Vincent de Paul. But despite the COVID-19 crisis, our SVdP Drop-In Center has remained open giving overnight respite and safety to homeless from all over the area, our Soup Kitchen has continued providing meals, and our Outreach Ministry is open and addressing crisis needs. Throughout this time, we have had to remain extremely focused to address the pandemic in the context of our ministries to accomplish three critical objectives:

- 1. Stay Christ-Centered and prayerful
- 2. Keep staff, volunteers, clients, and the facilities safe from COVID-19
- 3. Continue to serve in faith those in need following all state and local directives

Six months later, I can gratefully acknowledge that we have been accomplishing these goals as we have started re-engagement according to protocols put forth by the state of Illinois. As we continue to move forward, we are complying with social distancing and safety requirements. Although our delivery of services is "different" we are striving to make services "better than ever."

These have been extremely trying times, but God is good, and He gives the grace. Thank you to all who have given us loyal and unconditional support. My prayer is that He continues to keep all of you safe, everyone at St. Vincent de Paul safe, and that He continues to give the grace that allows us to serve in the shadow of His peace.

SVdP BLESSED WITH VISIT BY BISHOP MCGOVERN

On September 3rd, Bishop Michael McGovern blessed St. Vincent de Paul with a visit to our Outreach Ministries at 3718 State St., East St. Louis. He toured the facilities and engaged in conversations and active listening to the



Gospel experiences of those who serve and those who benefit from the mission and spirit of SVdP charity and justice goals. "This introductory visit in East St. Louis and visits to other poverty areas of our Diocese have provided me both inspiration and insight of the challenges we face, our needs and of how we might better

respond" he said. Bishop McGovern ate lunch at the soup kitchen and shared discussions with Vice President, Joe Hubbard and Executive Director, Pat Hogrebe about the programs and services that St. Vincent de Paul extends to its outreach to the poor and marginalized throughout the diocese of Belleville as well as through the 20 parish SVdP conferences in southern Illinois. At the end of the day, the Council was elated and overwhelmed by the concern and compassion that the Bishop expressed for the charity work being done by St. Vincent de Paul.

We serve breakfast and a hot lunch Monday - Saturday Because of social distancing only 35 people are allowed in the dining room at one time and we have a staff person at the door full-time to monitor all precautions and insure all requirements are met.

SVDP Outreach Ministry Center

We are open Monday-Saturday for Computers, Showers, Laundry, and Free Clothing Services.

HELP CENTER SERVICES at the Outreach Ministry Center are offered Monday through Thursday from 8am to noon. To comply with all Social Distancing precautions, we are seeing people by appointment only. The call line is 618-398-0680. Everyone please leave a message and our scheduler, Rose Jordan, will call back with an appointment time within 24 hours.

DROP-IN CENTER

BY THE GRACE OF GOD, THE DROP-IN CENTER HAS **NEVER CLOSED!**

The second family room was completed and has been a beautiful blessing.

We are currently housing an average of 42 people a night.

We have added a large, covered porch on the store side of the Drop-In to accommodate our large numbers. We are in the final stages of installing the wraps on the porch posts and the benches and tables.

SVDP COUNCIL COVID-19 CHARITY

In response to the overwhelming crisis COVID-19 has caused for families throughout the diocese, the Council has applied for special grants to assist with rent and utilities. We have been able to give more than \$30,000 for COVID related requests and have just received another \$30,000 to help prevent evictions and utility disconnects. All these funds have qualifying and accounting requirements and are being distributed through applications completed through the Help Center.
