WELCOME to the 2025 season for the Show Hors-e Association!

We are very excited to bring you a new format, designed to increase education and promote achievement without breaking the bank.

The following date(s) will be observed, in order to provide ample opportunity to all participants:

- 1st of the Month: Entries open, patterns released
- 20th of the Month: Entries closed, videos can be submitted at any time between entries opening and closing, but must be submitted prior to 11:59 PM CST on the 20th
 - All entries must be uploaded via YouTube and granted appropriate viewing permissions for our judge(s) to access (instructions at back of show bill, if needed).
- Last day of the Month: Results announced, feedback provided to exhibitors.

OPEN: For those of all ages, professional and non-professional.

AMATEUR (AM): For adults 19 & over who are non-paid exhibitors (they may not train, give lessons or receive remuneration for such).

YOUTH (YA): For those of all ages 18 & Under. *If there are less than two in a division, 14-18 and 13 & Under may be combined.

GENERAL INFORMATION

There are no ownership or breed requirements to participate. We ask that attire is kept clean and professional, though show clothes and show tack are not required. Any youth exhibitor and all exhibitors showing over fences must wear an approved ASTM helmet.

For the purposes of year end awards, points received will follow specific horse/rider combinations, except in the equitation over fences and on the flat, which will follow the rider. To be eligible for year end awards, exhibitors must purchase an annual membership prior to points being earned. Exhibitors must show a minimum of four times in a division during the year to be eligible for year end awards.

Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter between the W/T and W/T/C divisions within any specific discipline. There is no restriction regarding riders with different horses.

Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

How to Upload a Video to YouTube and Share a Public Link

What do I need to upload a video to YouTube?

You need:

- 1. A video file on your computer.
- 2. A Google account to sign in to YouTube.

How do I sign in to YouTube?

- 4. Fill in the details for your video, such as title, description, and tags.
- 5. Choose the visibility option "Public" so anyone can view your video.
- 6. Click "Publish" or "Save" when you're done.

How do I get the public link to share my video?

- 1. After uploading, YouTube will provide a link to your video on the upload confirmation page.
- 2. Copy this link.
- 3. You can also find the link by going to "Your videos" under the profile icon, clicking on the video, and copying the URL from the address bar.

How do I share the video link?

- 1. Paste the copied link into your entry form under the "Video Link" section.
- 2. Anyone with the link will be able to view your public video.

Can I change the visibility of my video later?

- 1. Yes, go to "Your videos" under your profile icon.
- 2. Click on the video you want to change.
- 3. Click on "Details" and select "Visibility" to change it to Public, Private, or Unlisted.
- 4. Save your changes.
