# FUNDS RECOVERY

## Keith Porter & Associates

As golf and country clubs get back to "business as usual" in the post-pandemic new normal, most have missed out on a government program designed to put money back in their pockets—in many cases because their accounting personnel believed they didn't qualify. Recently, two well-known clubs



were able to navigate the updated guidelines of the Employee Retention Credit (ERC) and receive six-figure refunds with the assistance of a Club Co-Op participant.



Keith Porter & Associates is available to work with Southern California PGA members to help make sense of the complex nuances of the ERC program, including the "partial suspension" language that many large accounting firms have actually overlooked. The funds recovered are paid in cash and do not have to repaid. Any recovery work on behalf of SCPGA members is done on a contingency basis, with no fees paid in the event that no funds are recovered.

In most cases, a 10-minute phone call can determine whether your club is likely to qualify for an ERC payout. Your SCPGA Co-Op contact is Keith Porter.
