State Law Updates & Our Path Forward as a Community

Washington State's WUCIOA (Washington Uniform Common Interest Ownership Act) will fully take effect on January 1, 2028, with some provisions beginning January 1, 2026, and it will replace existing HOA laws statewide.

The FGHA Board is working closely with our legal counsel to ensure ongoing compliance and to prepare required updates to our bylaws. Because these updates will require approval from 67% of FGHA homeowners, legal counsel has recommended holding the vote at the September 22, 2026 Annual Homeowners Meeting to ensure timely compliance.

In the coming months, our bylaws will be reviewed and proposed updates will be shared with homeowners. This will be an important opportunity for us to plan ahead, and grow stronger as a community. Questions or concerns may be emailed to: contact@fairwoodgreens.org.

We're happy to share that 2026 dues will not increase and will remain \$450, the same as 2025, payable either annually or semiannually in January and July 2026.
