Update from Your Treasurer

Thank you to all the homeowners who submitted their January 2025 semiannual (twice a year) FGHA dues on time! On time payment saves the association time and money that is spent on multiple follow ups with delinquent homeowners.

Your Board has been working diligently to spend association money wisely and save money where we can, through careful and creative negotiations, evaluation of projects and gratefully utilizing the numerous homeowner volunteers who generously offer their time and energy. We were on track to finish the 2024-2025 fiscal year (Sept 2024 to Aug 2025) under budget with the goal to have no homeowner dues increase for the next budget year. We will communicate next year's budget plan in the August mailing for the Sept. 23 annual FGHA meeting.

The Role and Goal of the PMC

The Property Maintenance Committee (PMC) plays an important and vital role within the FGHA. Some of the important factors of why people want to live in the 1,500 home community of the FGHA include; safe, family friendly, aesthetically pleasant, houses and properties are kept neat and tidy, and property values are maintained or increasing. The PMC team conducts regular drive around compliance reviews of the 1500 homes and properties and looks for potential violations of the FGHA Rules & Regulations. If potential violations are noted, friendly reminders are sent out from the HOALife software that is used to manage this effort. The FGHA was established in the late 1960s and the goal of the current all-volunteer and fellow homeowner Board and PMC members is to keep the community up to the standards that have been in place since the late 1960s. This is accomplished by ensuring that all 1,500 homeowners comply with the FGHA Rules & Regulations. So if you receive a friendly first violation notice, these are reminders to attend to the violation and bring it back into compliance. Thank you for your ongoing understanding and cooperation and keeping FGHA up to standard!
