PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR SERVICE BY UNITED STATES MARSHAL

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(c)(3) and Local Rule 4 of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Plaintiff Raymond E. Butler II, proceeding pro se, respectfully moves this Court for an order directing the United States Marshals Service to serve the summons and complaint upon Defendants Georgia N. Alexakis and Nancy L. Maldonado. In support of this motion, Plaintiff states as follows:

1. This action was filed on or about September 2025, and the case remains in the early stages. Defendants are federal judges assigned to the Everett McKinley Dirksen United States Courthouse in Chicago, Illinois.
2. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m), service must be effected within 90 days of filing the complaint. Plaintiff has diligently attempted to

serve Defendants through standard means but has been unable to complete service to date due to access restrictions and security protocols at the federal courthouse, which have impeded personal service efforts.

3. Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(c)(3) provides that, at the plaintiff's request, "the court may order that service be made by a United States marshal or deputy marshal or by a person specially appointed by the court." This provision grants the Court discretion to order Marshal service even in non-in forma pauperis cases, particularly where good cause exists, such as difficulties in serving government officials or judicial personnel. See, e.g., Fed. R. Civ. P. 4 advisory committee's note (1993) (noting the rule's flexibility for challenging service scenarios).
4. Local Rule 4 of the Northern District of Illinois supplements Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4 by addressing summons issuance, waivers, and service in specific contexts, including habeas proceedings where Marshal service is mandatory. While Local Rule 3.3(g) mandates Marshal service without prepayment in cases where in forma pauperis status is granted under 28 U.S.C. § 1915, the Court retains authority under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(c)(3) to order Marshal service in other circumstances upon a showing of need. Here, Plaintiff is not proceeding in forma pauperis but requests this relief due to the practical barriers encountered.

5. Plaintiff has prepared the necessary USM-285 forms (Process Receipt and Return) for each Defendant, as required by the United States Marshals Service for service of process (see 28 U.S.C. § 566(c) and United States Marshals Service Policy Directives on Service of Process). These forms are attached hereto as Exhibit A (for Defendant Georgia N. Alexakis) and Exhibit B (for Defendant Nancy L. Maldonado). The forms specify personal service at the Defendants' known addresses within the Everett McKinley Dirksen United States Courthouse and include all required information, including the requester's contact details. Plaintiff requests that the Court direct the Clerk to forward these forms, along with copies of the summons and complaint, to the United States Marshals Service for execution.


6. Ordering service by the United States Marshals Service will expedite this matter, ensure compliance with service deadlines under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(m), and avoid further delays. Plaintiff is willing to bear any associated costs if the Court deems it necessary, though the prepared USM-285 forms indicate no advance deposit is required at this stage.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests that this Honorable Court:

(a) Enter an order directing the United States Marshals Service to serve the summons and complaint upon Defendants Georgia N. Alexakis and Nancy L. Maldonado pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(c)(3);

(b) Direct the Clerk of the Court to provide the United States Marshals Service with the necessary copies of the summons, complaint, and attached USM-285 forms.
