We are pleased to invite you to the exhibition, organised by the International Centre for Studies of Arts and Humanities (ICSAH) and the Cornaro Art Institute, Cyprus. The exhibition will be carried out as part of a scheduled cultural programme that incorporates Science, Arts, Literature, and Music, and precedes the homonymous International Conference organised by (ICSAH) and Dante Alighieri Society of Nicosia in cooperation with the Libera Università Internazionale degli Studi Sociali Guido Carli (Luiss) and the Università Pontificia Salesiana that will take place at May 2023 in Rome (venue TBA).

The exhibition will take place at the Cornaro Art Institute, Keramopoieiou 1A, 3040 - Limassol, Cyprus, from 7th to 10th October 2022. Applications are open until 15th September 2022.











Abstract. It is more than a cliché that gender plays a crucial role in religion, as most religious orders in the world were, and currently are, dominated by men. The role of women in cultic settings is, as a rule, secondary, as is also the authority of female ministers of religion, while the social benefits of those appointed with religious duties are also incomparable with the privileges received by men. Hence, this year we invite works that explore the female share in leadership roles related to religion (such as goddesses, saints, prophetesses, priestesses, nuns, preachers, witches, shamans, gurus, heads of religious orders and more), and/or explore attitudes towards such women. We welcome works that deal with all religious systems from ancient to present times.
