ABOUT LITTLE EGG HARBOR

Little Egg Harbor is a waterfront township in southern Ocean County known for its coastal feel, boating access, local businesses, and laid-back community atmosphere. The township describes itself as a place with scenic landscapes, strong local history, community events, and a welcoming small-town feel. It is also home to neighborhoods like Mystic Island, which adds to its shore-town character.

Little Egg Harbor has deep historical roots. The township says its name came from Dutch sailors, who named the nearby bay for the eggs they found in gull nests, and the first known account of the area dates back to 1614. The first European settler identified by the township was Hendrick Jacobs Falkenberg, connected to one of the earliest land purchases in the area.

Today, Little Egg Harbor offers a mix of year-round residential living and shore lifestyle appeal. It has an estimated 2024 population of 21,587, with 47.35 square miles of land, giving it a spacious feel compared with denser shore towns. That makes it appealing to people looking for more room while still being close to the water and outdoor recreation.

THINGS / DO

- Walk the Graveling Point Trail. This trail is in Little Egg Harbor Township and runs through beach and salt marsh, with views of Great Bay. It is also a popular fishing spot.
- Explore Great Bay Boulevard Wildlife Management Area. NJ Fish & Wildlife describes it as a 5,982-acre estuary-and-islands area, which makes it great for wildlife viewing, nature photography, and a scenic drive out toward the bay.
- Visit Freedom Fields County Park. In Little Egg Harbor, this county park has softball, soccer, and Little League fields, plus picnic areas and hiking trails.
- Check the township recreation calendar. Little Egg Harbor's recreation department posts community activities and seasonal events such as the Green Fair, Senior Expo, and other township programs.
- Spend a day at Tuckerton Seaport. Just next door in Tuckerton, the seaport offers historic and recreated buildings, exhibits, live aquatic displays, and creek tours, so it is one of the closest "destination" outings for Little Egg Harbor.
- Go birdwatching or hiking at Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. The refuge's trails and Wildlife Drive are open daily from sunrise to sunset, and it is one of the best nearby spots for marsh views and birding.
- Use Ocean County parks for outdoor time nearby. Ocean County Parks highlights activities like hiking, biking, canoeing, fishing, playgrounds, and picnic areas across its park system, including southern Ocean County locations.

COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS

- Little Egg Harbor Chamber of Commerce — a volunteer nonprofit that supports local businesses and promotes the Little Egg Harbor area.
- Great Bay Regional Volunteer EMS — the local volunteer EMS organization serving Little Egg Harbor and Eagleswood; it also participates in community events, CPR classes, open houses, and fundraisers.
- Little Egg Harbor Fire District No. 1 — the township fire district that supports fire protection and training for volunteer firefighters serving the community.
- Little Egg Harbor Recreation Department / Recreation volunteers — the township recreation page includes volunteer opportunities for community events and programs.
- Little Egg Harbor Environmental Commission / Green Team — a volunteer-driven township commission focused on protecting natural resources, sustainability, and community education.
- Friends of the Little Egg Harbor Branch of the Ocean County Library — a local library friends group that helps support library programs and community involvement.
- Rotary Club of Great Bay — a service organization serving Little Egg Harbor and nearby communities through fundraisers and local service projects.
- Pinelands Youth Jersey Shore Baseball & Softball — a volunteer-driven youth sports organization serving Little Egg Harbor and nearby towns.
- Pinelands Basketball Association — a local youth basketball organization that uses Little Egg Harbor schools and facilities for games and programs.
- Tuckerton Historical Society — a local historical organization with its museum site listed in Little Egg Harbor, helping preserve and share area history.
