THINGS / DO

Outdoor & Nature Activities

Local Parks & Trails

- Plainsboro Preserve – A huge nature preserve with walking trails and McCormack Lake — perfect for hiking, birdwatching, picnics, and peaceful outdoor time.
 - Morris Davison Park – A popular community park with playgrounds and open space.
 - Mill Pond Park – Scenic park ideal for a relaxing walk, especially near the pond.
 - Schalks Meadow Park – Great for casual strolls and enjoying green space.
 - **Lenape Trail & Lenape Trail Parking Lot – Trails ideal for walking, biking, and nature exploration.
 - Millstone River Park – Riverside park great for walking and relaxation.
 - Plainsboro Village Fountain – A local landmark to enjoy a quick stop and scenic views.
- Nearby larger outdoor spaces worth a short drive:
- Mercer County Park – Wide open spaces with hiking, sports fields, and fishing.
 - Delaware and Raritan Canal State Park – Long canal towpath trails great for biking and walks.

Museums & History

- Wicoff House Museum – Historic house museum offering insight into local history.
- Princeton University Art Museum – World-class art museum just a short drive away (in Princeton).
- Morven Museum & Garden – Historic museum & garden in Princeton showcasing art and history.

Libraries & Community Spots

- Plainsboro Public Library – Local library with community resources.
- (Also nearby) Princeton Public Library – Larger library with programming and events.

COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS

Local Nonprofits & Community Organizations

In or very close to Plainsboro:

- Plainsboro Public Library – Library offering programs, community groups, and networking events.
- Plainsboro Recreation & Community Services – Local recreation and community programs including volunteer opportunities.
- Youth Orchestra of Central Jersey – Music and youth arts organization for local students.
- Sew A Future Inc. – Nonprofit focused on sewing and related services.
- Plainsboro Non Profit Housing – Affordable housing nonprofit serving the community.
- U Matter Project – Local nonprofit (check mission and programs).
- Fish Foundation Inc – Community nonprofit (local address).
- Nearby & regional organizations useful for support or involvement:
- Princeton Medical Center Foundation – Health system fundraising/community support.
- West Windsor-Plainsboro Education Foundation – Supports local schools and education programs.
- Princeton Area Community Foundation – Grants and support for local nonprofits and community projects.
- Friends of Princeton Open Space – Land conservation and community events in the region.
- American Red Cross – Volunteer opportunities in disaster response and preparedness.
- Community Options, Inc. – Supports people with disabilities.
- Jewish Family & Children's Service – Social services and community support.
- Young Audiences New Jersey & Eastern Pennsylvania – Arts education nonprofit.
- Civic & Volunteer Opportunities
- Plainsboro Rescue Squad – Local volunteer EMT/ambulance service that often welcomes volunteers (e.g., mask drives or support roles).
