WHEREAS, the City of Falls Church acknowledges and celebrates Algerian history, culture, and unity with Algerian American community members;

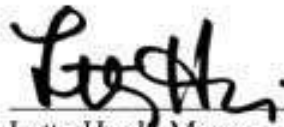
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Letty Hardi, Mayor of the city of Falls Church, do hereby proclaim November 1st, as
