- 1. Call to Order Meeting was called to order at 0905 by Base Commander Hladik. A guorum was present.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance Jay led base members in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. Previous Minutes Dale read the minutes from July. Jay motioned to approve the minutes as read, Mark seconded, minutes approved.
  - a. Reminder to vote for National and District Officers. This can be done by logging in on the National website <a href="https://www.ussubvets.org">www.ussubvets.org</a>, then clicking on the [Vote Nat Election] button near the top of the left menu.
- 4. Treasurers Report –Jim provided a report of a balance of \$2,274.99 on deposit, and petty cash again of \$95.00. Only activity was deposit of funds collected at the July meeting. Detailed records are available upon request. Dale motioned to approve the report, Mark seconded, report approved.
- 5. OKC Subvets Website and Facebook page (Todd, via email to Dale)
  - a. In Facebook was added (1) Robert Zahrn's Holland Club Presentation, (2) A welcome to new base members: Robert Zahrn and Gary Palmer, and (3) August Meeting Event.
  - b. On the Website:
    - i. Created an 'Events Happening" tab and moved "Flash Traffic" merged "Base Photos" under this tab. Base photos are now broken into specific years (ie 2024, 2023, 2022, 2021, 2020 and before). Format for 'Base Event Gallery' pictures has been modified to show text to the left of photo.
    - ii. Under the 2024 Base Event Gallery tab was added: (1) Robert Zahrn's Holland Club Presentation, and (2) 2024 LibertyFest including photos from the filming of the USSVI-OKC Feature on KOKH Channel 25. This includes a link to the video on Youtube.
    - iii. Under the History of USSVI-OKC tab was added (1) Liberty Fest Parade, and (2) Interview for the KOKH feature.
  - c. Worked with Dale to submit a write up of the base's 6th participation in LibertyFest to the editor of the American Submariner.
  - d. Still working on an update of the SOP for the website. When completed, then training for Don LaBlanc as assistant webmaster will be scheduled.

- 6. USS Oklahoma commissioning (Don)
  - a. COB (YNCSM(SS) Chris Reed) is compiling a list of all First Term sailors that have received their dolphins and the dates so we can catch up. He stated that there is no longer a "submarine requalification" requirement. You are now considered requalified when you regualify your senior watch.
  - b. Regarding personal events (babies, marriage) he will provide information with their approval. Additionally, he suggested that if there is a local quilting group that wants to donate "baby blankets" for OKLAHOMA babies that would be great, with the blankets having designs or patterns themed to the state.
  - c. Don is working with the COB to take orders for coins, belt buckles, and hats (Note: it was later determined hats are not available yet). Orders need to be to Don no later than 17 AUG 2024.
    - i. USS Oklahoma Challenge Coins \$20.00 each.
    - ii. USS Oklahoma Belt Buckles \$40.00 each. Order must specify Officer, CPO, or Enlisted.
- 7. Hats and Challenge Coin (Mark) No new information. Coins are available for purchase.
- 8. Don LeBlanc Project Work is still in progress.
- Steve Damlo Project Dale presented a sample of what the card would look like. After discussion Mark moved to have membership cards created, based on the example shown. Gabe seconded. MOTION CARRIED. ACTION: Dale & Steve
- 10. Yukon Czech Festival Parade Saturday October 5, 2024 After discussion it was agreed to participate in this parade (ACTION: Chuck). Questions about candy, and also what to do for the October meeting will be discussed at the September meeting.
