2019-20 Year in Review

- Tornado Response
 - Full activation of EOC
 - Immediate overnight response followed by long-term management of 3 neighborhoods for 6+ weeks
 - 3,000+ properties assessed
 - 160+ traffic signs and 8 signalized intersections replaced/repared
 - 59,000+ cubic yards of debris removed
 - Coordinated 300+ volunteers
 - Have issued 580+ building permits and conducted 1,500+ inspections



2019-20 Year in Review

- COVID-19 Response
 - Focus on maintaining continuity of City operations by reallocating resources and rethinking operations and staff
 - Emphasized educating the public on ever-changing guidance and orders
 - Constant coordination with federal, state, 2 counties and 2 ISD officials
 - Attention to facility enhancements to provide social distancing and safety
 - Maintained outreach and engagement with key stakeholders via remote strategies
 - Developed nursing home task force for immediate response to spikes in cases

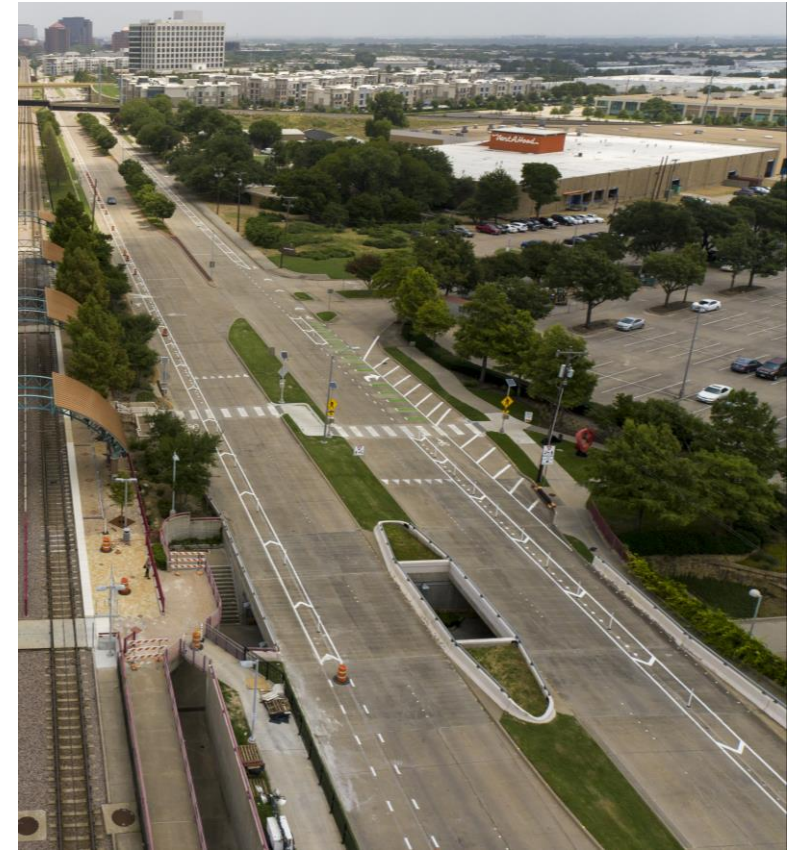

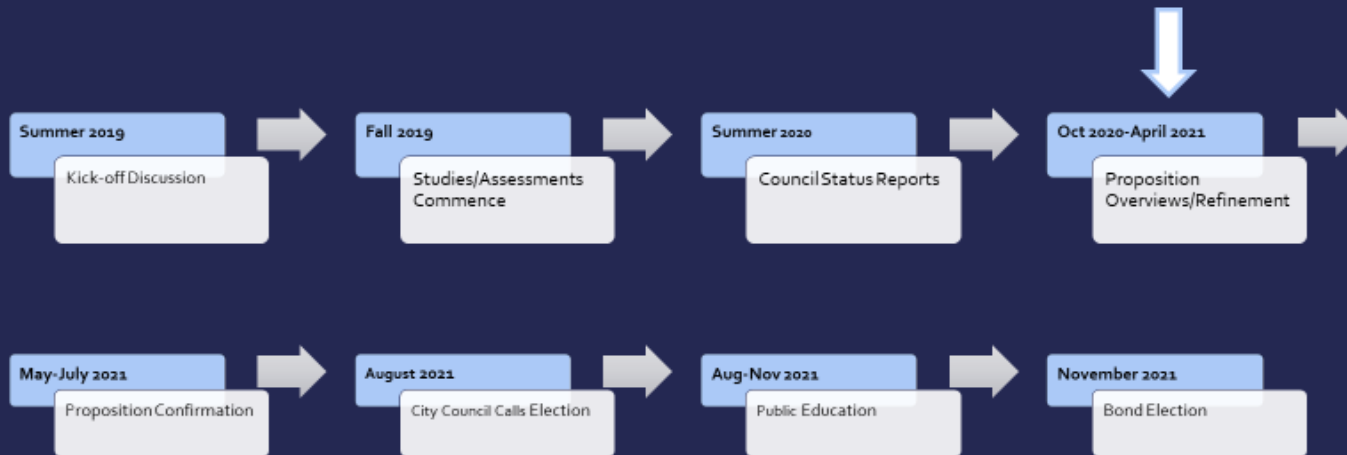
