

Pine Grove HOA Swimming Pool Rules

The hours for Pine Grove HOA swimming pool will be posted annually during the swim season. (6 am – 10 pm)

- Swimmers swim at their own risk.
- Entrance for members is by access card only.
- All persons using the pools should do so with the utmost care and caution to avoid accident and injury, not only to themselves, but to others.
- All residents must have current Pine Grove HOA dues to enter the pool area. Periodic checks may be performed to ensure pool usage is restricted to residents and their guests only.
- Guests must be accompanied by a Pine Grove HOA resident at all times.
- All swimmers must shower before entering the pools.
- All swimmers must wear swim suits; the HOA have the final decision on determining appropriate swim attire.
- Children not potty-trained **must** wear all of the following while in the pool: a swim diaper, rubber pants and proper swim garments.
- Solo swimming is not recommended.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult or person over the age of 16 at all times. Children between the ages of 12-15 must not swim alone.
- If any child requires the use of a personal floatation device and cannot swim, a responsible person must supervise such child and always be within arm's reach of the child.
- NO bikes, roller blades, scooters, skateboards, hoverboards, or like items allowed in pool area, or on the sidewalks around the common areas
- No running, pushing, wrestling or boisterous conduct is permitted in or near the pool.
- No glass or glass bottles, sharp objects or hazardous materials are allowed in pool area.
- No food in pool.
- No pets or animals allowed in pool area.
- Absolutely no profanity of any kind is permitted.
- Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose etc., are strictly prohibited in the pools.
- Smoking or e-cigarettes is not permitted in the pool or inside the fenced area.
- Persons with open cuts, wounds, sores, rashes, blisters, open lesions or other potentially hazardous conditions or any communicable condition may not use the pool. Any and all bandages must be removed before entering the pool. Do not swim if you had diarrhea within the past two weeks.
- A fine of \$100.00 will apply to negligent members who allow their child/guests to enter the pool without the proper swimming attire and cause the pool to close due to fecal contamination.
- Any resident or guest of a resident breaking these rules is subject to having their pool privileges suspended.
- Groups over 8 must schedule as a party.
- Pine Grove HOA members are allowed 3 Parties in the clubhouse area per summer. A fee of \$50 for each party over 2.
- A Party in the clubhouse area does not reserve the pool. The pool is open to all members
- NO swimming allowed during heavy rain or when thunder and lightning can be seen or heard.
- **In the event of an emergency dial 911.**
