Purpose and Need

The purpose of this project is to improve State Route 4 from Stallion Way to just west of Stockton Road. The project will bring the last three miles of unimproved SR 4 in Calaveras County up to current highway design standards. This will help reduce accidents and move traffic more efficiently. In addition, this project will provide a reliable east-west trucking and agricultural route. Engineering design and acquisition of property rights will be completed by the summer of 2026. Construction could begin in 2027.
