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I am writing in response to your request for access to information to Emergency Health Services (EHS) under the *Access to Information Act (ATIA)*

The location may be referenced as MacEwan LRT Station, 10515 105 Avenue NW, or 104 Street and 105 Avenue, Edmonton.*

*This request includes, but is not limited to:*

- Ambulance Call Reports*
- Dispatch records and timestamps*
- Unit identifiers*
- Crew notes*
- Transfer of care or scene handover documentation*
- Any EMS records referencing Edmonton Police Service attendance or interaction*

*Please include records for all EMS units that attended, were dispatched, placed on standby, or otherwise involved at this location during the specified dates.*

*If any portion of the records is redacted, please provide the remainder in accordance with ATIA requirements. I am requesting these records in electronic format.*
