Dear Friends in Jesus Christ,

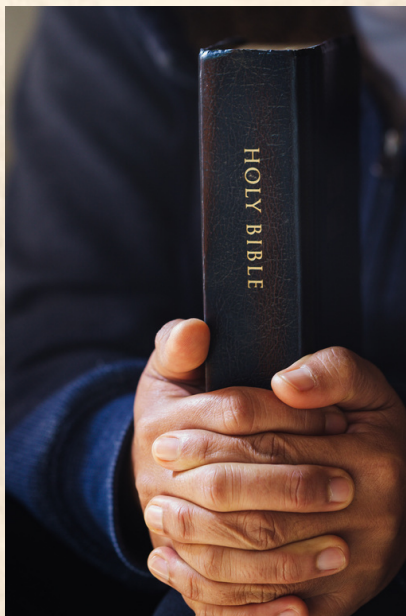
Have you ever found yourself in a moment of isolation, wondering how God might call you to serve unexpectedly? That moment came during the COVID-19 pandemic 2020 when the world stood still, but the Word of God remained alive and active.

As a Divine Word priest, I was entrusted with caring for a sprawling 14-acre farm, cultivating wheat, soybeans, lentils, and vegetables. In the silence of those fields, far from the busy rhythm of community life, I was drawn into deep reflection. While the world battled uncertainty, I pondered how to proclaim the Good News to people who felt isolated and needed hope.

Social media had become a lifeline for many. Masses were streamed, spiritual talks went viral, and the Word of God reached living rooms across the globe. Inspired by this digital evangelization, a spark ignited within me: '2 Minutes with the Lord' was born—a daily Gospel reflection delivered in less than two minutes. I began recording voice messages and uploading them to YouTube, Instagram, and Twitter. Those two-minute reflections were my humble offering to share Christ's love.

For three or four months, the project blossomed. But as the world slowly returned to normalcy, so did my responsibilities. I was reassigned to a new mission as the treasurer of the Province, moving from farm to finance. My channel went quiet, a seed buried in the soil, waiting for its time.

Two years passed. In 2023, the Lord whispered again, calling me to revive this ministry. I returned to '2 Minutes with the Lord with renewed zeal.' To my amazement, the channel flourished in ways I had never anticipated. What started as a simple voice message has become a platform for sharing God's love, wisdom, and peace with countless souls. The blessings have been abundant—a hundredfold.



Looking back, I realize that God's call often comes in life's quiet, unexpected moments. The words of our founder, St. Arnold Janssen, resonate deeply with me: "Proclaim the Gospel where it is not preached." Today, social media has become a new frontier for mission, and I am humbled to be a small part of this great task. This Advent, as we prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ, I invite you to journey with me. Let us embrace new ways to proclaim the Word of God and shine His light in our digital age.

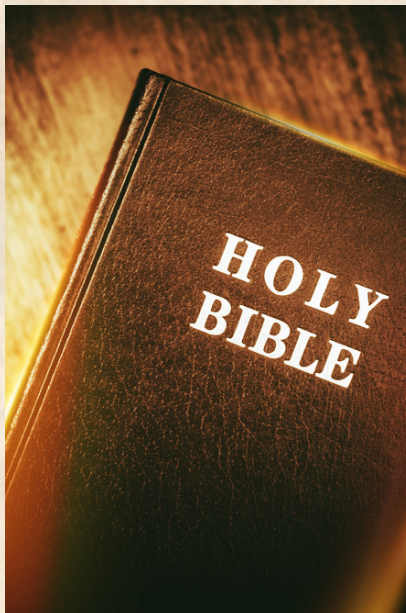
In your daily life, how do you respond to such a gift? Perhaps it's in trusting His promises, sharing His love with others, or simply spending two quiet minutes in gratitude.
