Start time 9:00 a.m.

Entries close at 9:00 pm on Thursday, June 6th. Post entries will be accepted, but will go to the top of the order.

Course walk will open at 7:30 a.m. and hand walking of horses in the arena will be permitted.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to horses ridden by Juniors, Amateurs or Professionals. Riders are not limited to the number of horses they may ride. Horses and riders may cross enter into any division for which they are otherwise eligible. Cross entry of horses into the Low Hunter Derby is not permitted.

**JUDGING:** To be scored under the open numerical judging system, by one panel of two judges. The top 12 will return for the second round in reverse order of their scores. Scores will be added to determine the winners. In the case of a tie, judges will confer to break the tie.

**First Round:** To be shown over a hunter classic type course of at least 10 fences 3' in height with four 3'5" options. Fences to simulate those found in hunting country, including natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence, coop, aiken, hedge, brush, logs and natural foliage. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality, substance and movement. After the judges base score is given, one point will be added for each high option fence jumped.

**Second Round:** To be shown over a hunter handy type course of at least 8 fences 3', with 3'5" options. To include elements such as roll-backs, tight turn options, trot jumps, hand gallop, halt and/or back, or work through a gate while mounted. To be judged on performance, hunter pace, style, quality, substance and movement, handiness and brilliance of pace. Handiness is defined as ground saving movement without adversely affecting performance or style. Brilliance of pace is defined as a faster pace than ordinary, without sacrificing performance or style.

### \$1,000 BRIARWOOD LOW HUNTER DERBY

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to horses ridden by Juniors, Amateurs or Professionals. Riders are not limited to the number of horses they may ride. Horses and riders may cross enter into any division for which they are otherwise eligible. Horse cross-entry into the National Hunter Derby is not permitted.

**JUDGING:** To be scored under the open numerical judging system. The top 12 will return for the second round in reverse order of their scores. Scores will be added to determine the winners. In the case of a tie, judges will confer to break the tie. Management reserves the right to change the class format of the class to a Hunt N'Go due to number of entries or weather conditions.

### COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

**First Round:** To be shown over a hunter classic type course of at least 10 fences 2'6" in height with four 2'9" options. Fences to simulate those found in hunting country, including natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence, coop, aiken, hedge, brush, logs and natural foliage. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality, substance and movement. After the judge's preliminary scores are given, one bonus point will be awarded for each high option chosen.

Second Round: To be shown over a hunter handy type course of at least 8 fences. To include elements such as roll-backs, tight turn options, trot jumps, hand gallop, halt and/or back, or work through a gate while mounted. To be judged on performance, hunter pace, style, quality, substance and movement, handiness and brilliance of pace. Handiness is defined as ground saving movement without adversely affecting performance or style. Brilliance of pace is defined as a faster pace than ordinary, without sacrificing performance or style.

AWARDS: Trophy & Ribbons 1st-12th, please ride for ribbons.



### \$500 BRIARWOOD HUNT N' GO CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY DERBY

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Riders are not limited to the number of ponies they may ride. Ponies and riders may cross enter into any division for which they are otherwise eligible.

**JUDGING:** To be scored under the open numerical judging system. A single score will be given by one panel of two judges.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS: Small and Medium ponies to jump 2' in height with 2'3" options. Large Ponies to jump 2'6" in height with 2'9" options. Fences to simulate those found in hunting country, including post and rail, coop, wall, aiken, hedge, brush and log. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality, substance and movement. The class format will consist of two phases (not two rounds), one Classic Hunter Phase, and one Handy Hunter Phase. The phases will be jumped consecutively with no break in pace. All participants will complete both the Classic and the Handy portions are stored for any life or patricipants.

both the Classic and the Handy portions even if penalties (rails, refusal, etc.) are incurred. Major penalties (falls, three refusals, off course, etc.) will result in elimination. A single score will be given by the judges. Bonus points of one point per high option jump will be added to the score.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations be read, understood and accepted. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT FEDERATION RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.
- 2. Please pre-enter using www.horseshowing.com Please include ALL necessary proof of recording for every OWNER, RIDER, TRAINER and HORSE! An incomplete entry blank cannot be issued a back number. A \$30 deposit will be required to make an entry into the show. Scratch Fee: \$30.00 Any post entries if accepted will incur a \$25 Post Entry Fee.
- 3. Entries for the Hunter Derbies close at 9:00 pm on Thursday, June 6th. Posted orders for the Derbies will be available in the Show Office after Noontime on Saturday, June 8th and will available online at www.horseshowing.com Post entries for derbies go to the top of the order.
- 4. Stabling may be offered, subject to availability. Fees: \$100 overnight stalls, \$75 day stalls. Bedding is available at \$12.00 per bag. Stabling reservations must be made with your online entry at www.horseshowing.com Hay and grain will not be available for purchase. Stalls and shavings must be pre-ordered by close of entries by 9:00pm on Thursday, June 6th.
- 5. All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on soundness and manners unless otherwise noted.
- 6. The Briarwood Farm Horse Show, Briarwood Farms Inc., the Committee, Katharine P. Benson, Duncraven Stables, or the property owners will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage which may occur to any horse, rider or equipment before, during or after the show.
- 7. Should any question arise that is not covered in the USEF Rule book the same shall be referenced to the Show Committee whose decision shall be final.
- 8. Failure to enter the ring within three minutes of being called will incur elimination.
- 9. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, change location, add or any class(es) or schooling sessions. All updates to the schedule will be available at www.horseshowing.com
- 10. Ties for first place in jumper classes will be jumped off, all others will remain tied receiving equal points, ribbons and prizemoney.
- 11. All riders must wear proper attire including proper ASTM approved headgear at all times mounted on the showgrounds.
- 12. Prizemoney and Championships will be awarded at the conclusion of the division at the show office. Please allow one-half hour for processing.
- 13. All pets must be leashed.
- 14. Jump orders will be constructed at the discretion of the show management by the steward.
- 15. A processing fee of \$50.00 will be made for all non-negotiable checks. Any returned checks not "made good" within 10 days will be forwarded to the USEF for collection.
- 18. MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule
- 16. Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
- 17. REGARDING MEASUREMENTS: Should the veterinarian on call be needed to complete permanent measurement of horses or ponies, then the appointed time for said measurements will be 10:00 a.m. ALL ARRANGEMENTS FOR MEASUREMENTS MUST BE MADE IN ADVANCE THROUGH SHOW MANAGEMENT BY THE WEDNESDAY BEFORE THE SHOW. Phone (908)-963-4698 for information and procedures. Day measurements will of course be available at any time throughout the show.



- \* No credit is awarded for an obstacle knocked down. If the fixed time is reached at the moment when the horse is already taking off (front hooves off the ground), this obstacle counts if it is correctly jumped.
- \* All disobediences are penalized by the time lost by the competitor. The competitor must withdraw after a fall. Nevertheless the rider scores the pledge obtained up to the moment of his or her fall.
