KMP Billet K20 Coil Bracket Installation Guide



For 1994-2005 Mazda Miata 1.8L

- LocTite (optional)
- Wiring Crimper and Connectors

Installation Steps:

Step 1: Preparation


Safety First: Ensure the vehicle is on a flat, stable surface, and the ignition is turned off.

Step 4: Wiring the Coils




Wire Routing: Route the ignition coil wiring harness along the designated paths, ensuring it is secured and away from moving or hot engine parts.


This is the harness that comes with the bracket kit. Cut to length as desired.



You will need to splice these wires from the oem coil connector and connect them to the supplied harness.



- 1- Brown/White
- 2- Black/Yellow
- 3- Black/White
- 4- Black



- 1- Green (coils 1-4)
- 2- Violet (coils 2-3)
- 3- Red (12V)
- 4- Black (Ground)

Secure Connections: Use wiring splicer tools and crimps to secure the connections between the wiring harness and the coils harness connector.

You will need to splice together and join wire colors below:

- 1- Brown/White with the Green wire
- 2- Black/Yellow with the Violet wire
- 3- Black/White with the Red wire
- 4- Black with the Black wire

Step 5: Final Checks

Double-check Connections: Ensure all bolts are tightened securely, and wiring connections are properly made.

Reconnect Battery: Reconnect the negative terminal of the battery.

Testing: Turn on the ignition and check for proper functioning of the coils.

Step 6: Post-Installation Inspection

Visual Inspection: Inspect the installation for any loose components or potential issues.

Test Drive: Take the vehicle for a short test drive to ensure the coils operate correctly.
