1875 - 1881	St. Mary's, Ontario, Canada	Born in Canada and then moved to Michigan at age 6 with his family.
Circa 1881 – 1896	Imlay City, Michigan	Grew up in Imlay City, 55 miles directly north of Detroit. It is not clear what he did right after high school graduation in 1891, perhaps still living at home. Records show that he was still in Imlay City in 1894.
Circa 1896 – 1900	Kalamazoo, Michigan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Received associate bachelor's degree from Kalamazoo College, likely in 1900 Lived together with his brother, Andrew Milton, at 42 Dormitory West
Circa 1900 – 1903	Location(s) unclear, perhaps Lafayette, Indiana	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Secretary of the YMCA for Purdue University in Lafayette, Indiana, likely from 1900 to 1902 Ordained 1902 June 1902 – Back to Imlay City as a guest of some friends Meets Bertha Buschman – when, how and where is unclear; perhaps she was home for Christmas 1902 just before he took the job at the Ocoya church March 1903 – Visiting friends on the west side of Lafayette
1903	Lafayette, Indiana	Marries Bertha in 1903 in August
Circa 1903 - 1904	Ocoya, Illinois	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ocoya was a very small town, approximately 100 miles southwest of Chicago on Route 66, now on Interstate 55. According to Wikipedia, the Baptist church there was built in 1871 but does not appear on a current map. Their first child, Dorothy Irwin Dinsmore, was born in Chenoa, Illinois, about 5 miles from Ocoya.
Circa 1904 - 1907	Harvey, Illinois (South Chicago area)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> He received bachelor's degree at University of Chicago in 1907 There are currently three Baptist church buildings in Harvey, two of which are boarded up. Abundance Baptist Church (corner of E. 154th Street & Lexington, New Bethel Missionary Baptist Church (corner of E. 154th Street and Broadway) and South Suburban Missionary Baptist Church (corner of E. 152nd Street and Lexington) Margaret Millson Dinsmore was born in 1907
1907-1914	Anderson, Indiana	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lead pastor for Anderson Baptist Church in Anderson, Indiana. 1911 - Their 3rd child, William James "Jim" Dinsmore was born there 1913 – Father died in Kansas City when he was 38 years old. He and several of his siblings had visited their father there in KC back in September of 1912.
1914 - 1915	Evansville, Indiana	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lead pastor for Baptist church in Evansville, Indiana Daughter Dorothy contracts and recovers from typhoid fever
1915 – 1931	Indianapolis, Indiana	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> General Superintendent of the Indiana Baptist Convention Completes doctorate degree at Franklin College in 1920 Their 4th child, Bertha Elizabeth was born there

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Registered for the draft for World War 1 - Registration Card says he was 43, living in Indianapolis with wife Bertha I Dinsmore at 438 N. Riley. His occupation is clergyman, and his employer is General Superintendent. Indiana Baptist Church. His height is listed as medium, his build as medium with brown eyes and brown hair
Circa 1931 - 1937	East Orange, New Jersey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Secretary American Baptist Home Mission Society 1931- September 1941 Their inferred residence in 1935 is East Orange, Essex, New Jersey.
Circa 1937 - 1941	Teaneck, New Jersey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The 1940 Census shows Carlos and Bertha's home at that time to be Teaneck, Bergen, New Jersey, and his occupation is Minister, and he owns their house, and that its value is \$8,500. His income is stated at \$4,500. The Census also states that he had worked 68 hours in the week prior to the census. Of course, this census does not provide the date for when he retired. When Mom & Dad were visiting them there, there are pictures of Bonnie Elizabeth Dinsmore Riordan with them in Teaneck when she was 7 months old. So, it had to be in 1937.
1941 – 1948	South Haven, Michigan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pastor First Baptist Church South Haven Michigan beginning in October of 1941 until he retired 1944 – Mother Mary Jane Beersheba Millson died in Kalamazoo, MI when he was 69 years Old. She had dementia. According to Who Was Who in America, Vol II. 1943-1950, he was a Republican World War II occurs Dies in 1948
