## COLD TEMPERATURES

During colder temperatures shrubs should not be trimmed as it exposes the fresh cut opening to the cold. Leaves may turn brown but that does not mean that your shrub is dead, it's winter damage. Leave them alone until the cooler temperatures pass.

We are expecting some unusually cold temperatures over the weekend and next week. You can cover any precious plants with sheets or cloth. If you use plastic, make sure the plastic is not touching the plant. Again, the leaves may turn brown but the roots should be safe.

## ANNUAL INSPECTIONS

The Architectural Advisory Committee will begin their annual inspections this month. This is an annual activity that started in 2005 and every year since that time for the betterment of the community. Our task list items include the typical pressure washing clean up, wood decay and painting, as well as courtesy suggestions to help you keep your investment in good repair.
