(A Special Period when George was a kid) (when a LOT of us were kids!)

1942 – 1946

From “**This Is The Army**” movie - 1943 – Irving Berlin

“Mandy,” “God Bless America”

“I Left My Heart At The Stagedoor Canteen”

“When I’m There In The Air, With My Head In The Clouds”

“Oh, How I Hate To Get Up In The Morning” /

“This Is The Army Mr. Jones”

“I’m Gonna Buy A Paper Doll” – 1942 (*released*) ; *written*, 1915, Johnny Black

3. Pop Songs – Post-1950s – “Calendar Girl” – more...

4. Parlour Music – 1820s – 20th C. examples:

“The Lost Chord” – *poem* Adelaide Proctor – 1858, *music* Arthur Sullivan – 1877

“My Grandfather’s Clock” – 1876 – Henry Clay Work

“As Time Goes By” – 1931, Herman Hupfeld – *sung*, Dooly Wilson, *film* “Casablanca” – 1942
