Welcome to another golfing season at Springhill Golf Club!



Male Dress Code

Suitable golf attire for all male junior golfers is defined as:

- Shirts with long or short sleeves
- No sleeveless t-shirts
- Pants or golf specific shorts
- · No tennis shorts, jogging shorts, gym shorts, cut offs
- Golf or tennis shoes only
- Hats are to be worn in the manner in which they were intended, golf visors and baseball-style hats with the brim facing forward

Female Dress Code

Suitable golf attire for all female junior golfers is defined as:

- Golf shirts, skorts, and short
- Sleeved or sleeveless shirts tops are acceptable
- No halters, strapless tops
- Golf or tennis shoes only
- No sandals or flip flops
- Hats are to be worn in the manner in which they were intended, golf visors and baseball-style caps with the brim facing forward



All of our instructional programs are based around a system that is modeled after a highly successful instructional program from the Future Links Canada Golf Program. Learn to Play is a four stage development program designed to align with child development principles and elements of the game specific to a child's needs as outlined within golf's Long-Term Player Development (LTPD) guide. By promoting and delivering Learn to Play at your facility, you will support a national initiative designed to teach the game of golf to junior's in a systematic approach and enable your facility to offer a "best in class" product to your customers. Our goal is to better provide Springhill Golf Club's junior golfers with a fundamentally sound skill set that will help them enjoy a lifelong success in the game of golf.



Our Junior Golf Academy is our junior golf program that provides the juniors a chance to develop their skills and have an opportunity to play on the golf course.

We are very excited to bring back the popular golf program in 2022 to our young juniors. The concept is to start at 25 yards from the green and score a 36 or better for 9 holes. Once achieved, golfers move back another 25 yards, so on and so forth.

The kids will learn to set achievable goals for their games and can experience success with this program.

Our developmental clinics will improve their skills and create confidence in their abilities. We will address the full swing, chipping and putting.

Learning and playing together is a great way to build long lasting relationships!

This code identifies the minimum standard that our junior golfers are expected to uphold. We believe that all junior golfers are capable of meeting these standards of both dress code and behavior. Golf is a game of integrity in which respect to your fellow competitor, the course, and the rules are an important part of the game.

SCGC Code of Conduct

Abusive or inappropriate conduct or language, including temperamental outbursts, throwing or breaking clubs, running on greens, disrespecting or not following directions from the coaches will not be tolerated. Out of consideration for the Springhill GC members and all Junior members, a violation may result in dismissal from the given program.

Violations of the Code of Conduct

Violations of the code of conduct will result in any or all of the following penalties based on the frequency or the severity of the code of conduct.

First offense: Verbal warning

Second offense: Junior member will sit out of the activity and parents will

be notified.

Third offense: Results in a removal from the program.
