
[Fun Facts, Tips, & Inspiration on the Writing Process for Aspiring Authors]


[Books I've Been Reading that I HAD to Share]

An Excerpt from GINA FAVA's collection of essays & recipes, UN MOMENTO: A Taste of Italian-American Pastimes:

Gina's Fava Bean Salad

Mom always makes this refreshing salad for outdoor picnics and barbecues, but its heartiness makes it a great side dish for any meal. Her recipe features fresh green beans from the garden or market. I improvised, because Gina Fava is partial to fava beans.

*wine pairing: Collio Pino Grigio

Ingredients:

- 4 c. shucked fresh fava beans
- 3 c. potatoes, chopped
- · 2-3 medium fresh tomatoes, chopped
- 1 cucumber, diced
- · 1 small red onion, sliced or chopped
- · 2 cloves, minced
- Olive oil and vinegar
- Basil, oregano, salt, and pepper to taste

Directions:

- 1. Boil beans and potatoes until tender.
- 2. Mix all ingredients.
- 3. Toss with oil and vinegar, and season.
- 4. Cover and refrigerate for at least three hours.
