Surplus Property – 1981 Ford Fire Truck Western States

WHEREAS, the Lewis County Fire District #3 periodically needs to sell or dispose of real property that is no longer needed because it has been replaced or has become obsolete; and

WHEREAS, a fire district has the ability to carry out their purposes and to that end may sell or dispose of property according to RCW 52.12.021; and

WHEREAS, a review of RCW 52 indicates that there is no mandatory statutory procedure required for the sale or disposal of property by a district; and

WHEREAS, the 1981 Ford Western States Fire Truck VIN #1FDYK90R3BVJ04500 is surplus property to be offered for sale to the public or to be disposed of if nonworking; and

WHEREAS, the Governance Board intends to follow a process for selling the property that is open, fair, and in the best interest of residents, property owners and taxpayers of the district;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Lewis County Fire District #3 Governance Board approves the surplus of the 1981 Ford Western States Fire Truck VIN #1FDYK90R3BVJ04500 vehicle and authorizes the Fire Chief to: (1) establish a schedule and process for sale of the property to another fire service entity or affiliated service entity; (2) establish a schedule and process for the public sale of the property; and (3) accept all sales as final on the announced date of sale without returning to the Governance Board for approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the district does not receive at least the minimum value for the vehicle, the Fire Chief has the discretion to either accept a lower bid or take the item off the list and arrange for a sale at a later date; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the district does not receive any bid for an item, the Fire Chief may declare the property as "salvage" and either recycle or dispose of the property.
