### **Public Safety or Fire Emergency Incident Mitigation Cost Recovery**

**WHEREAS**, RCW 52.12.021 authorizes “any and all lawful acts required and expedient to carry out the purpose of this title [52]” (fire protection); and

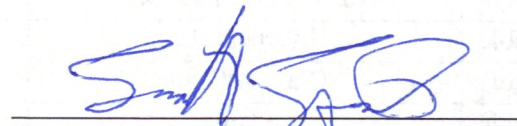
**WHEREAS**, the recovery of costs that are incurred while protecting life and property in response to minor and major emergencies and disasters, such as, but not limited to: replacing supplies/equipment, periodic/scheduled/repair maintenance of apparatus/equipment, and personnel expenses that are required to maintain the district’s ability to provide protection to life and property; and

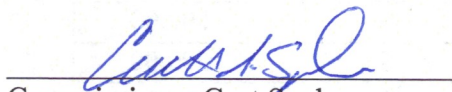
**WHEREAS**, Lewis County Fire District #3 will not balance bill any patient or property owner (private or commercial) on any claim for any reason to both residents and non-residents of the district.

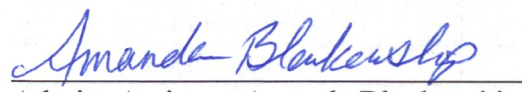
**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Lewis County Fire District #3 Governance Board authorizes the submission of requests for the collection of emergency response costs in Exhibit A from the responsible party at any public safety or fire emergency incident, to include, but not limited to: a false alarm more than 2 times per month, hazardous materials release, illegal fire, rescue, structure fire, vehicle fire, vegetation fire, motor vehicle collision, emergent medical response and utility line failure or breach. If no responsible party can be identified, the property owner (real or personal) shall become the responsible party.
