Features

Unit comes with everything needed to start except for adhesive tanks

Self-contained with onboard battery compressor (no external cords or hoses)

Each nozzle can be turned on/off to spray variable width patterns

5' Carts hold 2 canisters, 10' carts hold up to 6 canisters

Pneumatically operated spray nozzle system uses a cordless 60V DeWalt compressor.

A single battery charge is sufficient for most operations

Benefits

Instructions

1. ZIP Cart™ ships via all common carriers
2. Assembly time is approximately 1 hour using common hand tools
3. Once the cart is pressurized with adhesive, it must remain pressurized
4. We DO NOT recommend cleaning adhesive plumbing between projects
5. The Wind Screen will need to be trimmed depending on the thickness of the membrane used on the job
6. The Wind Screen can be replaced with leftover membrane as needed
7. Only maintenance on unit:
 - a. Periodic replacement of the windscreen with scrap membrane due to adhesive buildup
 - b. Annual replacement of nozzles/gaskets (~\$50/replacement set)
8. Different adhesives may affect the pressured spray. JM and Firestone adhesive canisters have less pressure, so when using their adhesive, we recommend turning off the two outside nozzles to ensure appropriate pressure for uniform spraying
