Code of Conduct

Bowlers must abide by the following code of conduct. Violations of the WYBT code of conduct will be reviewed by the tournament directors. Consequences for violating the code of conduct will either be listed in the WYBT rules and/or up to the discretion of tournament officials.

- Bowlers must act professionally and responsibly during tournament play. Behavior is not limited to the bowler. Any parent, coach, or guest that violates conduct rules may be asked to leave and may be refused entry to future WYBT events.
- 2. Bowlers must be respectful and practice good sportsmanship with competitors.
- 3. Bowlers must be ready to bowl when it is their turn.
- 4. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the settee area during tournament play. Bowlers may talk to coaches, parents, and spectators outside of the bowler's area.
- 5. No cell phones, headphones, or earbuds may be worn or used during practice or tournament play.
- 6. Bowlers may question the reasoning for any decisions but will ultimately understand any rulings made by tournament officials are final.
