Gamma Xi Boulé Celebrates Academic Excellence

Archons and Archousai from Gamma Xi Boulé gathered together on May 26 to celebrate the accomplishments of two outstanding area high school graduates during the 5th annual Matthew Carter Scholarship Awards Ceremony. The Gamma Xi Boulé Foundation created the Matthew Carter Scholarship to honor Archon Carter, who was a charter member of Gamma Xi Boulé, as well as a national officer of Sigma Pi Phi. The Scholarship awards a total of \$16,000 per awardee with payments of \$4,000 for the four years of their college career.

Matthew Carter Scholarship recipients are students from Manatee, Sarasota, and Charlotte counties who plan to attend four -year accredited colleges or universities. Students must graduate with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and commit to pursuing a degree in one of the following fields; business, finance, science, math, health, or the humanities.

The Gamma Xi Boulé Foundation awarded its 2018 Matthew Carter Scholarship to Dequontez Lavender, a 2018 graduate of Booker High School in Sarasota, Florida. Mr. Lavender graduated with a 4.0 GPA and he will matriculate as a business administration student at Morehouse College in Atlanta, Georgia in the fall.

Last year's awardee, Marc Brunot, will enter his sophomore year at Florida Gulf Coast University in Ft. Meyers, Florida in the fall and he will continue his studies as an accounting major. At the ceremony he received his 2nd installment of his scholarship funds totaling \$8,000 so far.
