This scholarship is presented by the Gamma Xi Boulé Foundation, Inc. directly to high school seniors for academic or technical/trade school expenses. An award is issued upon proof of enrollment in a four-year accredited college/university or a technical/trade school leading towards a Certification. Eligibility is based on successful graduation from high school.

The Gamma Xi Boulé Matthew Carter Scholarship Program will provide a \$4,000 scholarship to the successful scholar.

Please complete and return application form for the Matthew Carter Scholarship on or before April 5, 2019.

Late applications will not be accepted. Criteria to apply for the scholarship includes the following:

1. Must be a graduating high school student.
2. A resident of Sarasota or Manatee County.
3. Grade point average of 3.0 or higher if attending college; GPA of 2.0 or higher for Trade/Technical School.
4. Must major in Business, Finance, Science, Social Science, Math, Health, Health Management, Arts, Humanities or attend a Technical/Trade School leading to a certification.
5. Must submit an official high school transcript.
6. Two letters of recommendation, including one from a school faculty member.
7. Evidence of leadership through work, school and/or community service activities must be submitted.
8. A maximum one page, typed statement on why you want to earn a degree or attend a Technical/Trade School. Tell us why financial assistance is required.
9. Must present proof of admission/acceptance into a two/four-year post-secondary institution or Technical/Trade School in the US at the time of the scholarship award.
