Dear Missions Partner:

This has been a momentous year for Landmark World Missions. Since the change in leadership we have been extremely busy working to assess and firmly grasp this great work. We have enclosed the 2021 Financial Report (along with your donor record if you gave to the work this year) as evidence of God's goodness. The report covers only the last half of 2021 which reflects the period when the new Board of Directors assumed responsibility for recordkeeping. By God's grace we can say the work is moving forward and there is a spirit of unity and anticipation among all involved. Below are some highlights.

- * Our Financial Statement reflects growth and stability. More has come in since this statement and we have \$17,000 raised for the new bus. We are looking for a good deal and hope to make the purchase soon.
- * We have started building a church in Marangu and have the funds in hand to finish the work.
- * Our new NGO in Tanzania is established and we will have our first board meeting on our February trip.
- * The orphanage playground is finished and looks beautiful! (See picture on back.)
- * The children went on their first field trip in December and it was a great success!
- * A Christmas banquet was held at the orphanage for children, workers, and 15 pastors. This is a step towards connecting the Tanzanian churches with the orphanage work.
- * You will notice a large amount paid in property taxes on the Financial Statement. We discovered there were many back taxes due on the orphanage property. We have already made several payments via a plan established by our lawyer and the government and should be paid up this year.
- * We have over \$1,300 in our Bible fund which will allow us to place over 130 Bibles in February!
- * Our Facebook page is consistently sharing photos and current information about the work and our new website is nearing completion.
- * There is a coop full of chickens on the orphanage grounds to produce our own eggs—a small step towards self-sufficiency.
- * We are closer to being able to receive more orphans and grow the work.
- * We have made great progress repairing and improving the orphanage grounds.
