



I hereby pledge to provide positive support, attitude and encouragement for my child as he/she participates in N1 Basketball by agreeing to all of the following:

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials, at all times.

I will place the emotional and physical wellbeing of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.

I will support coaches and officials working with my child to model appropriate behavior and encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I will remember that youth sports are for the children and not for the adults.

I will do my best to make participating in sports fun for my child.

I will help my child enjoy their experience by being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching or volunteering as needed and whenever possible. As a fan, I will refrain from inappropriate language or gestures aimed at officials, coaches, other volunteers or children.

I will require my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, gender, creed, or ability.

If at any point I have a concern for my child's wellbeing I will follow the grievance procedure as outlined by N1 Basketball.

In the spirit of good sportsmanship I understand that I am accountable for my own conduct as well as for those attending on my behalf.

I understand that any person who: (a) engages in verbal or physical threats or abuse towards any coach, official, parent, or player; and/or (b) initiates a fight or scuffle with any coach, official, parent, or player, and/or (c) violates the athletic code of conduct, shall be banned from attending future practices, games, and all other subsequent events.

I also understand that any coach, official, parent, or player who violates the athletic code of conduct, and is banned from subsequent events, may petition for permission to resume attendance. As part of the petition, the banned person must submit proof of completion of an anger management course (through either a public or private source) before they can resume attendance.

24 HOURS RULE

There is a 24-hour game/practice rule with regard to communicating with the coaching staff. Game situations can be very emotional, and our policy on concerns is to be address 24-hours after such an event. The same applies for practices. Parents' should wait 24-hours, then proceed to call to make an appointment with the coach to discuss grievances. At no time are parents allowed to discuss situations immediately after a game.

All parents or guardians of N1 Basketball participants are expected to adhere to this Parents Code of Conduct. The acknowledgement below is receipt of this Parents Code of Conduct and Grievance Procedure. I further understand that failure to comply with the above may result in removal from an event.
