Frequently Asked Questions

1. May I use my original sheet music be ok to use?

Yes.

2. Will there be changes to the music?

Yes, there will be minor changes. Those will be given to you on the Zoom in July as well as sent out via email.

3. Do I need to memorize?

No. You do need a black folder or black tablet cover if using iPad or Android.

4. When will we know what the planned rehearsal schedule is?

- a. **Friday, Nov 21:** Four-hour afternoon rehearsal - tentative 1-5pm
- b. **Saturday, Nov 22:** Four-hour morning rehearsal - tentative 9am-1pm

- c. **Sunday, Nov 23:** Dress/Tech/Performance at Lincoln Center - All Day!
There will be a break to get changed into concert attire.

5. Is there a host hotel?

While there is no host hotel, there will be a central place to rehearse to be announced. We are working with FOR A Travel for accommodations or you may make your own arrangements.
