

2022 GUILD/QUILT SHOW CHALLENGE

BLACK AND WHITE PLUS ONE

Rules

Block is to be 20" x 20" (finished).

Block is to consist of three colors: black, white, and one additional color.

Additional color is to be drawn at a meeting or by calling Faye Kunz and requesting that a color be drawn on participant's behalf.

Colors are:	Blue	Purple
	Green	Red
	Orange	Yellow

After drawing, participant's name will be entered in a registry for the color drawn. Participant may re-draw one time prior to entry on the registry and may trade color with another participant as long as so noted in the registry.

Any combination of the color drawn may be used in the block (for example: multiple blue fabrics may be used if the color drawn is blue.)

Block may be pieced, quilted, and bound OR be left as an unfinished block.

Unfinished blocks will be donated to the Guild for use by the Charity or Habitat for Humanity committees.

Blocks will be shown at the September 2022 combined meeting with prizes awarded for the 3 blocks voted on by Guild members. Blocks may be entered in the 2022 Quilt Show Challenge category. Finished quilts and unfinished blocks may be judged or unjudged. Black and White Plus One (Color) should be used in the name of the block in order to ensure that blocks are hung together in color order.
