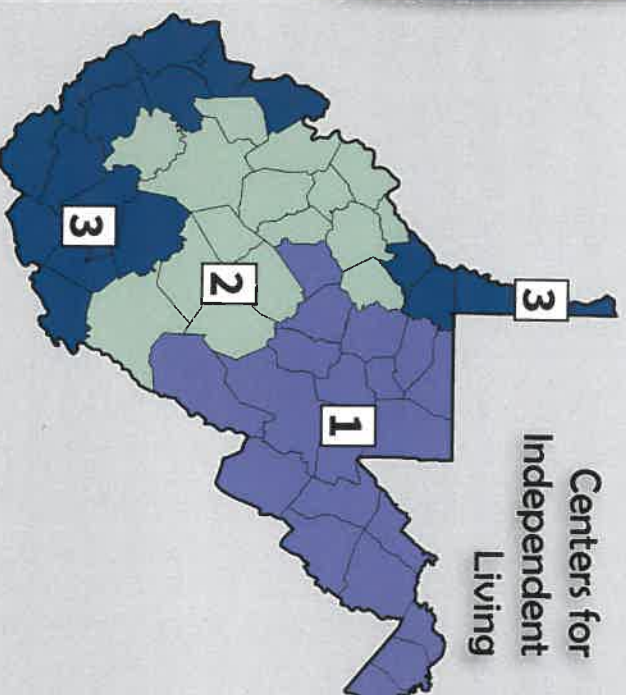

- Ramps
- Accessible bathrooms
- Other modifications to make homes accessible

Assistive Devices & Equipment

- Amplified telephones
- Lift chairs
- Other devices that allow a person to maintain their independence

Vehicle Modifications

- Vehicle conversions, lifts to accommodate wheelchairs & scooters
- Hand controls
- Other specialized modifications

Durable Medical Equipment

- Shower chairs
- Walkers
- Wheelchairs or Scooters
- Other durable medical equipment that allows a person to maintain their independence
