The <u>WV Independence Network (WIN)</u> is a network of partners (Centers for Independent Living) that provide services, resources, and advocacy to maximize the independence and inclusion of individuals with disabilities.

All proceeds generated from the Freedom Car Show will go directly to the <u>Community Living Services Program (CLSP)</u> managed by the WIN. CLSP is a statewide program that purchases assistive devices, durable medical equipment, home modifications, wheelchair ramps and vehicle modifications for economically eligible individuals with disabilities.

CLSP services help West Virginians with disabilities remain in or return to their homes and communities by enabling them to function more independently.

The goal for the Freedom Car Show is to help raise funds for the WIN and educate the public on what the Centers for Independent Living do to make WV a better place to live, work, and play for people with disabilities. For people with disabilities, living independently is Freedom.

Limited space is available and previous year vendors have priority. Failure to submit a photo or illegible applications may be rejected. Extension cords of at least 100' should be enough to supply you with electricity.

Applications must:

- be submitted by September 27, 2024.
- include a photo of the concession setup.
- be accompanied by a menu of products.
- include a copy of your insurance policy no less than \$1 million.
- include a \$75 fee per stand
- must be setup by 11am the day of event
