Our route winds through the Maryland and Virginia countryside, over river and stream. In your printed directions you'll be given the choice of several places to visit along the way, among them: the Hattie's Garage collection of 25 cars, 1908-1970, Early American Auto Repair (a restoration shop), a historic grist mill, the C.S. Arms antique firearms shop, Harpers Ferry National Historical Park, and perhaps a couple other places.


(This year we've decided to put our traditional "observational quiz" on hold, so that you can turn your full attention to enjoying the scenery!)

We'll meet at the Burkittsville Ruritan Club (500 E. Main St, Burkittsville, MD 21718) at 10:30 AM. Cars will be released onto the route starting at 11:00 AM (and for the next half hour). We suggest you grab lunch and visit restrooms before arriving. The nearest gas at the start will be outside Brunswick, Md., but there are stations along the route. There's "real" gas at the Liberty in Charles Town (321 W. Washington St., Charles Town, WV 25414). Park car trailers at the Ruritan and pick them up at the end of the day.

After the tour, a barbecue dinner will be held at the Blue Ridge Volunteer Fire & Rescue hall, outside of Bluemont. (Dinner reservations required.)

As always, the Tour will be held "rain or shine". If it rains, drive a modern car (if necessary). We'll still have a great time and see some beautiful scenery. And several of the stops along the way will be under cover. So, join the fun. Bring friends, family, your "orphan" and your thirst for adventure!

CORONAVIRUS: *On April 15 we will review the pandemic situation and make a decision to proceed with the tour if the outlook's good. Masks and social distancing will be observed. If dinner reservations are running low due to participants' health concerns, we may need to cancel the dinner portion of the Tour. DIRECTIONS: Take Rte. 17 north from Rte. 340 or south from Rte 70 / 40 / Alt 40, to Burkittsville. Go east on Gapland Rd. 1/4 mile to Ruritan Club.

Buffet menu: choice of barbecued glazed grilled chicken or smoked beef brisket; herb roasted potatoes; whole green beans with shallot butter or roasted asparagus (chef's choice); roasted carrots with brown sugar & butter; tossed salad with assorted dressings; rolls & butter; assorted cakes & pies; sweet and unsweetened iced tea, water and coffee.

Postmark reservations by **May 25** (if you miss the deadline, call us anyway.) Meal tickets will be given out at the Tour. If you cancel after **June 1** we can't guarantee a refund, but will try to sell your ticket for you if you alert us before then.
