The Junior & Teen EIRSDC competes in Acro, Contemporary, Hip Hop, Jazz, Lyrical, and Tap. You can learn more about the EIRSDC here. Final placements are contingent upon the Expresser's audition scores, performance season attendance and attitude displayed during the audition. Levels are sets of skills, abilities and concepts in each genre that increase in complexity as an Expresser progress. Parents/Guardians may ask the instructor to evaluate their Expresser on the first day of class if there are questions about ability or readiness. Have a more advanced dancer? Due to the popularity and talent levels of the program, all students wishing to advance their placement in the upper levels must submit an audition for each class that they are looking to place in.

Expressers are expected to spend at least one performance season, and often two or more performance seasons, at a particular level before moving on to the next level.
