Henry for Music (HFM) is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization (est. 2015) that relieves cost barriers to bring youth and instruments together, transforming lives through the Gift of Music. HFM obtains, refurbishes, and maintains musical instrument donations for Youth of all ages and backgrounds to enable access and participation in band, orchestra, or musical class.

An affiliate of the Henry Arts Alliance, this is Henry For Music's fourth educational concert experience promoting musical artistry and advocacy in all school environments—public, private, homeschool, kids in transition (homeless), foster/guardian care, and the SWAG Program.

HFM's Youth Orchestra United (YOU) program, established in 2016, facilitates musical education for Strings students without access to a musical program, including homeschoolers. The Mentorship program offers the opportunity for students to mentor, tutor, and gain foundational leadership knowledge. The HFM YOU After-school Enrichment Program is currently in three schools with over 40 students and a demand for more.

Pianist **JAMES "JEZ" GRAHAM** has been a fixture on the Atlanta music scene since 1988. You can hear him on piano at Hartsfield Jackson Atlanta International Airport in Concourse A (Friday evenings) by Varasono's and at The Piano Bar (Saturday, Sunday, and Tuesday) in Concourse E. A prolific Singer/Songwriter/Arranger, he released his newest solo album of 23 original songs, "Percolate," on April 1st, 2022. July 1st, 2022, saw the release of "The Jez Graham Collection," a 50-song retrospective. Jez served as musical director and keyboardist/vocalist on the 11/11/22 release of the "David Marks And The Summertime Blues Live At Eddies Attic" collection featuring original Beach Boy member David Marks. Trombonist **KEVIN ARNEY** began playing trombone during the 7th grade in South Florida public schools after having learned to read music through several years of piano lessons. "Band was my favorite subject, and I spent a lot of time practicing or just blowing the horn." Kevin achieved first chair in the 1979 Florida All-State Concert Band, joined his high school's chorus program, and began arranging. Kevin majored for two years in Studio Music & Jazz at the University of Miami´s School of Music. After that, he toured with a live band for four months, followed by nine months on a cruise ship, and in 1985 went on musical hiatus after starting a career with Miami-Dade County. In 2015, nearly 30 years later, Kevin retired, moved to Georgia, and returned to frequent playing, singing, and arranging with Big Bands, Dixieland Bands, Salsa Bands, and various other ensembles. He has recently played Trombone with The Henry Players ("Cabaret") and The Front Porch Players ("Music Man").
